

IPSF Patient Counselling Event Coordinator 2008

IPSF currently has a vacant position for PCE coordinator from February 2008 till August 2008.

The main objective is to help coordinate and organize the Patient Counselling Event at 54th IPSF World Congress Romania, by organizing clinical scenarios for competitors as well as run a workshop prior to the competition to assist students in essential communication and counselling skills to compete.

Similar PCE events may also be required for the Regional Symposiums for Asia Pacific and Pan-America, which does not require personal attendance but will require input and distant guidance for local Organising committee. This will also be good practice before the World Congress.

Throughout the year, the PCE Coordinator will also need to assist with interested IPSF members and CPs to run PCE events at local or national levels.

The PCE Coordinator must have regular internet access for emails and will also be an integral member of the Professional Development discussion mailing group and report to the IPSF Chairperson of Professional Development.

Preferable qualities include previous experience as organiser or competitor in past PCE events at IPSF, national or local level, and able to attend the World Congress in Romania from 1-11 August 2008 with sufficient personal financial support.
